conduct Legal Awareness Workshops for members to address the plethora of legal issues facing women in the country.

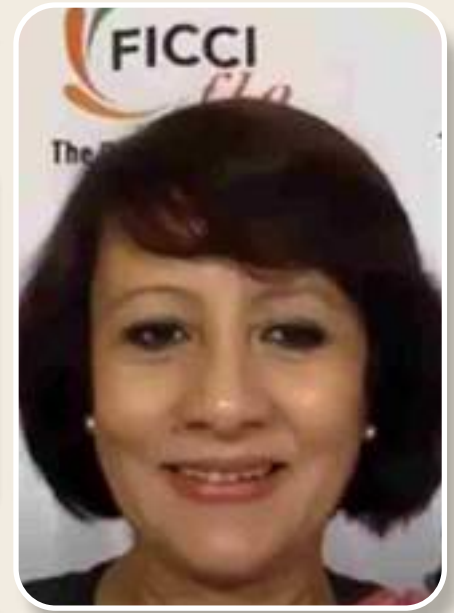
